



# DPS16 V3.02 Operating System Upgrade

This is to announce the release of V3.02 operating system for the DPS16 Digital Personal Studio. This is a maintenance release with the following improvements from V3.0:

## [Improvements:]

1. File Allocation Table management has been improved when editing short cues, (e.g. Copy in the Edit mode).
2. When changing the Effects settings from the Multi-band Compressor Expander (MBCX) to another effect via MIDI System Exclusive, the main screen is changed to FX1 only. It now allows changing to FX2 - FX4.
3. When copying the PProject Settings from one Project to another Project with a different sample rate (FS) in the Project mode (Project > More > Settings), the time data (e.g. IN/OUT, Locate memory) will be calculated to the appropriate times on the basis of destination sampling rate (FS).

## [Corrections]

1. When you perform Edit copy, level change, etc., in the Edit page on the particularly complicated cue, the DPS16 may lock up with SYSTEM LOCK error message. — *fixed* —
2. When performing a Normalize function with a particular cue, a strange sound may appear on the other tracks even if they have no cues on the LCD display. — *fixed* —
3. When you perform Sample rate conversion, e.g. from 48kHz to 44.1kHz, in the Virtual Track page, higher harmonics Noise may be added on the low frequency sound. — *fixed* —
4. When you make an Audio CD with Disk At Once in the Project > CD-R page, Index number may not be recorded on the Audio CD correctly. — *fixed* —
5. When you perform track copy with a particular track (e.g. with different bit rate) in the Virtual track page, the system may lock up with SYSTEM LOCK error message or may not copy a sound correctly. — *fixed* —
6. When you perform "Edit Cut > Insert / Repeat: more than 2" at particular time settings, the sound may rarely be copied to the wrong position (with a few seconds offset). — *fixed* —

## [Note]

1. No operator's Manual or Addendum has been release for V3.02 since there are no operational changes implemented in the new software.
